If Dogs Were Teachers

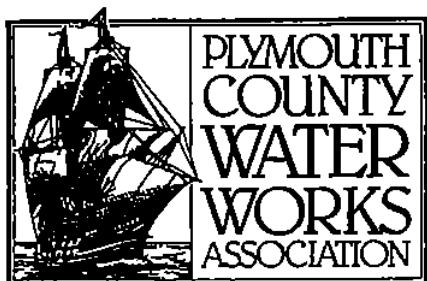
